East Midlands in Bloom Seminar to be held on Wednesday February 15th 2012 at Newark Town Hall, Market Place, Newark, Nottinghamshire NG24 1DU

The Workshop will be on the first floor in the Ballroom; there is currently no lift available but the steps are shallow. Disabled visitors can be dropped off outside the Town Hall as there are no free disabled parking spaces.

Registration is from 10 am for 10.30 and concludes with lunch at approximately 1.00 pm.
The EMiB AGM will follow at 2.00 pm.
A member from each group that entered the 2011 EMiB campaign is entitled to attend.

Parking – There is no free town centre parking. The nearest car park is the NCP multi- storey with entrance on Lombard Street, roughly opposite Asda, with pedestrian access about 250-300m from the Town Hall entrance. It is about 2 minutes walk from car to Town Hall steps.

Current charges are £2.50 per day for anyone parking before 9.00am. After that it is normal charges –

1 hr	£3.00
1-2 hrs	£4.40
2-6 hrs	£5.90
Over 6 hrs	£6.50

The Castle railway station (east west trains) is 5 minutes walk away, Northgate station (north south), is 15-20 minutes walk. Most people would take a taxi. The bus station is the opposite side of the road to the NCP car park.
